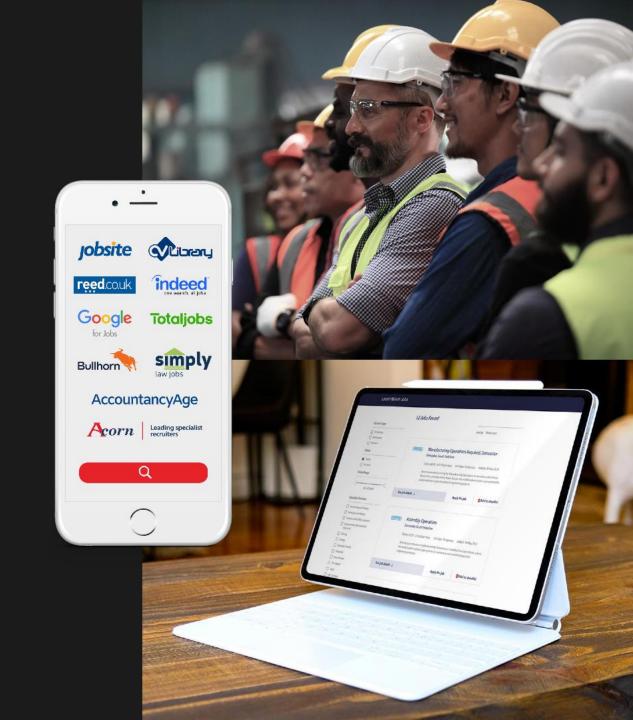
Offensive or Defensive

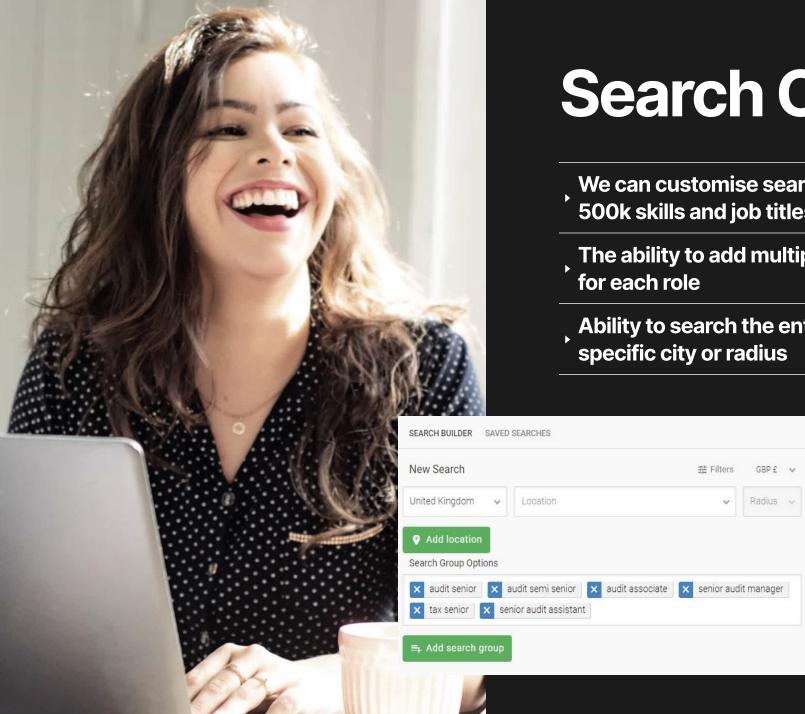

We regularly utilise Horsefly to benchmark current salaries to ensure existing employees packages maintain parity with competitor organisations







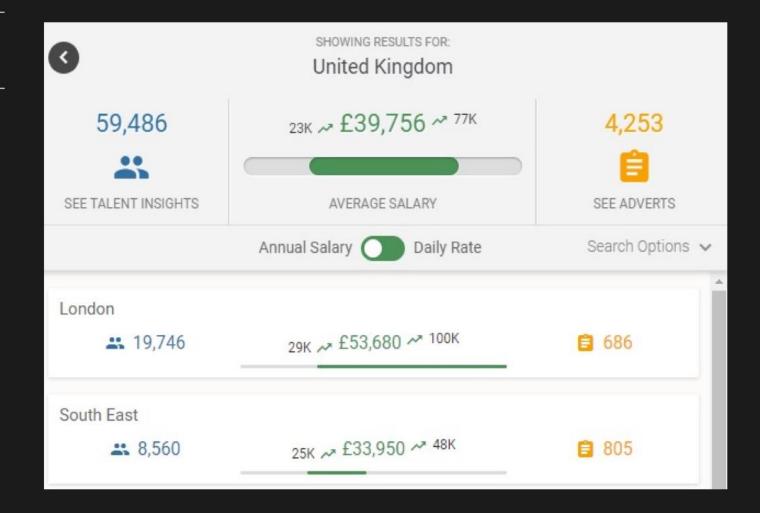
